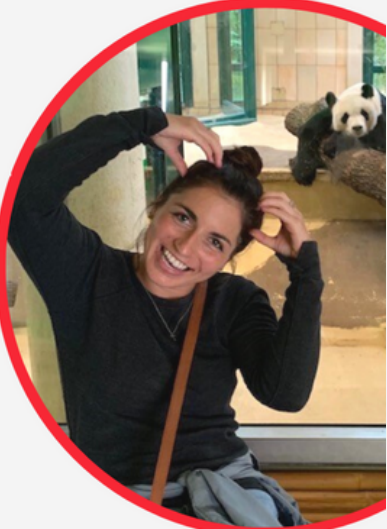

Auxiliary Board Impact

Since its inception, the Auxiliary Board has raised more than \$1,000,000 in scholarships. All annual member dues directly fund the **Auxiliary Board Scholarship** which supports students at seven partner schools in Chicago: Holy Angels School, St. Angela School, St. Sylvester School, Visitation School, Our Lady of Tepeyac Elementary School, Our Lady of Tepeyac High School, and Leo High School. On average, 66 percent of students attending a Big Shoulders Fund school are from low income families. For Auxiliary Board supported schools, the average is 78 percent. Your commitment helps to provide scholarships to some of our highest need students.

SCHOLARSHIP

- 45 students received an Auxiliary Board Scholarship in 2020-2021.
- \$51,000 was raised for scholarships in 2020-2021 through fundraising.
- 60% of Auxiliary Board Scholars are Hispanic / Latino, 36% are Black/African American.
- The average family income of an Auxiliary Board Scholar is \$37,000.

SCHOOLS

- More than 40% of members volunteer at schools.
- \$51,000 was raised last year to support 7 Auxiliary Board schools.
- Members volunteered more than 1,000 hours of service totaling to \$26,800 of volunteer labor in 2019!
- The schools committee hosts 5 Give Back Days per year averaging up to 150 volunteers.

STUDENTS

- More than 700 students have received the Auxiliary Board scholarship since its inception.
- 100+ students have received free high school test preparation classes, through volunteering, saving families nearly \$25,000.
- Students are invited to the annual Auxiliary Board Scholarship Reception.

Furthermore, Auxiliary Board members expand their personal impact by inviting alumni groups out to Give Back Days, creating new partnerships through organizing corporate service days, and multiplying their annual contributions by receiving a matching donation from their workplace, inviting friends and connections to socials and key events. Members are an integral part of Big Shoulders Fund's future and annual impact.
